

# Rainwater Recycling



Rainwater reuse systems work on the same principle as old cisterns. They collect rainwater from the roof, filter it, and place it in a storage tank. This water can then be used to water gardens and landscape or wash vehicles. It can also be filtered and treated, making it safe to drink. This can help offset high water bills, minimize the impact of restrictions on public water supplies or act as an excellent backup water source if a well fails.

Systems can be as small as a rain barrel next to the house or as large as a 5000 gallon underground tank.
